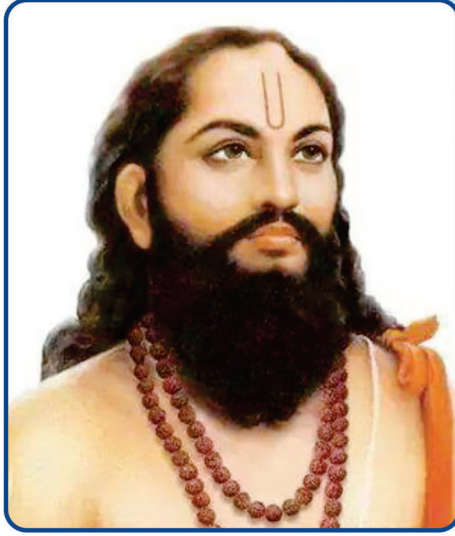

  7. लेखक का नाम, पद, आदि शीर्षक के साथ पृथक् पृष्ठ पर हों आलेख में कहीं भी न दिया जाये।
